The Battle Of Jericho

Joshua 6,7



- God told Joshua that he was going to give Jericho into the hands of the Israelites. He gave Joshua specific instructions in what to do.
- The Israelites marched around the entire city once a day for six days. Each day the priests blew the trumpets, but the rest of the people did not say a word. On the seventh day, they marched around the city seven times. On the seventh time, the priests made one long blast on the trumpets.
- Joshua said to the people: “Shout, for the Lord has given you the city.”
- The walls fell down and the army killed all the people and destroyed everything, but the spies protected Rahab and her entire family as they had promised they would.
