## Mary Anoints Jesus' Feet



Matthew 26; Mark 14; John 12

- When Jesus was on His way to Jerusalem to die, He stopped at Simon's house for dinner. During dinner, Mary, the sister of Lazarus, took very expensive perfume and poured it on Jesus' head and feet.
- Judas complained that the perfume should have been sold and the money given to the poor. Judas didn't care for the poor, but only wanted to steal the money for himself.
- Jesus told Judas not to bother Mary. He said that the perfume was to prepare Him for His death, and that what Mary did would be preached all over the world in remembrance of her love for Him.
